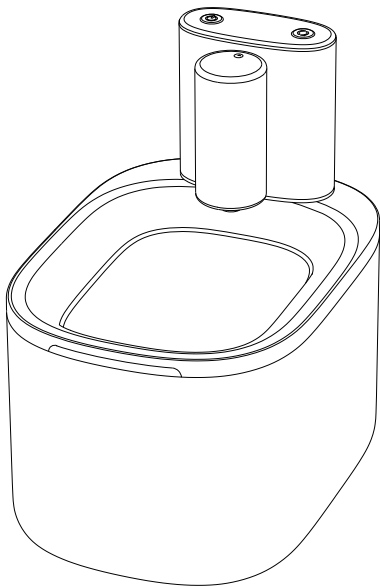

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SAFETY PERCAUTIONS

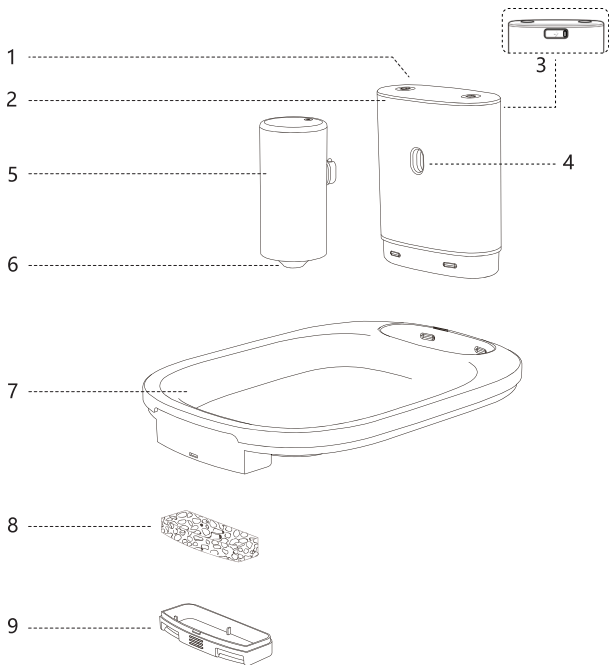
! Warning

- Dispose all packaging materials properly. Keep the polybags away from children and pets as these bags could cause suffocation.
- DO NOT place any foreign objects in the water tank.
- DO NOT use the device for anything other than its intended use.
- Only use accessories recommended by the manufacturer. The use of accessories other than the recommended specifications may cause unsafe conditions.
- DO NOT modify the device.
- DO NOT operate the device if the unit is malfunctioning or has been damaged. Do not attempt to repair on the device. Contact our customer service immediately for further instructions.
- Disconnect the power supply when the device is not in use.
- Disconnect the power supply before cleaning the device.
- The power adapter and the cable must never get wet.
- This product is for indoor use only
- This product is should not operate without water.
- DO NOT use the device in the bathroom.

CAUTION

- DO NOT allow pets to chew any parts of the device. If you are concerned regarding the power cord, purchase a cord conduit to protect the power cord.
- If an extension cord is necessary, one unit with a proper rating can be use.
- DO NOT install or store the device where it will be expose to weather or temperatures below 0°C / 40°F.
- To maintain compliance with FCC's RF Exposure guidelines, this device should be place with a minimum distance of 20cm from your body.

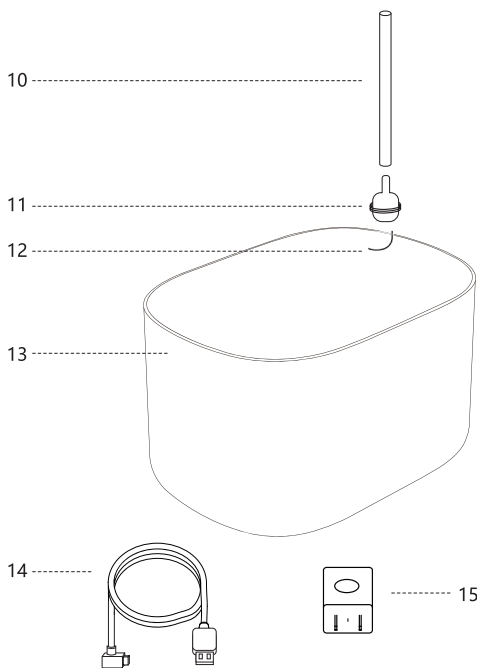

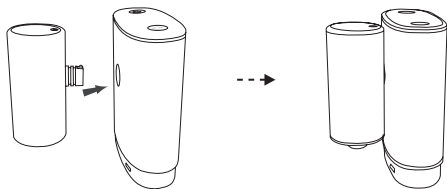

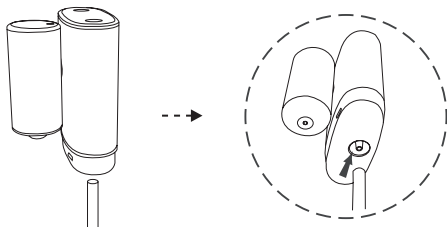

ASSEMBLING THE DEVICE

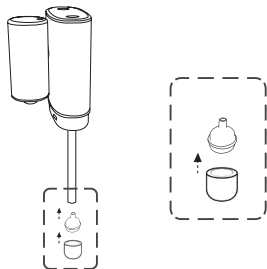
1. Install the UF Filter Cartridge to the Control Hub.



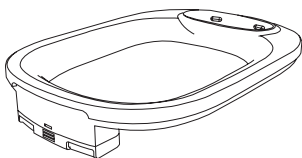
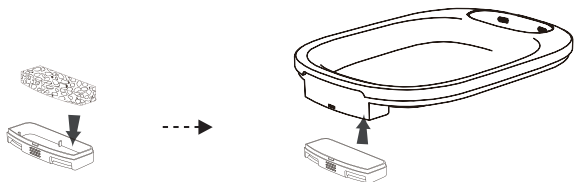
2. Attach the soft water pipe underneath.



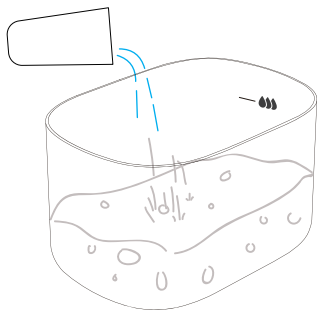
3. Attach the water inlet and the spherical filter to the pipe.



4. Place the foam filter in the filter compartment and attach the compartment to the water tray. (Press and pull down to remove the filter compartment)



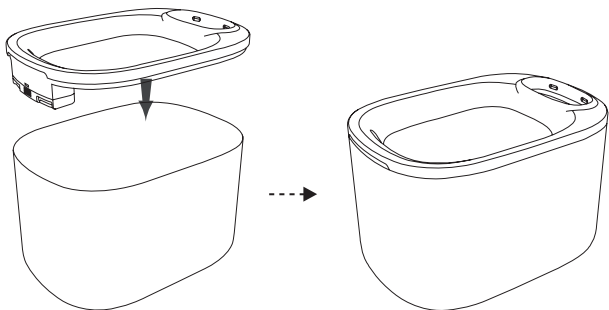
5. Pour water in the water tank.



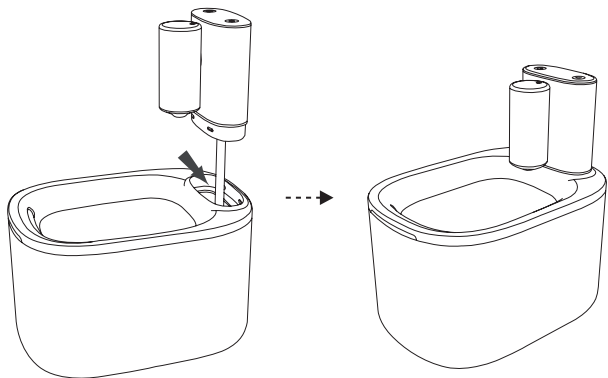
Note

Do not exceed the maximum water.

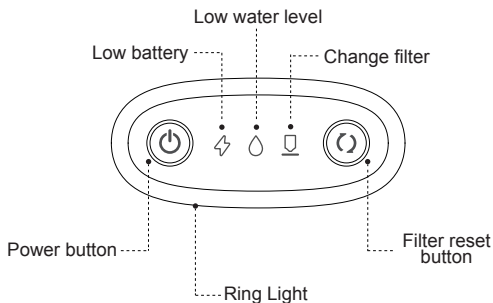
6. Place the water tray on the water tank.





7. Place the Control Hub on the water tray.

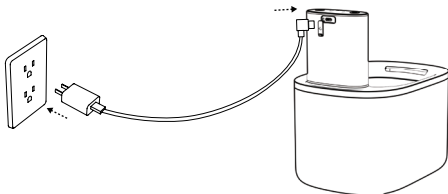

OPERATING THE DEVICE

The device can be powered either by direct power or wirelessly using the built-in rechargeable battery.



The battery requires 5 hours to be fully charged. The device can be use while it is charging.

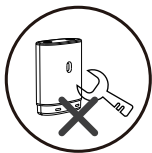
The Battery Management System (BMS) will automatically stop charging the battery when it has reach full capacity.

⚠ To extend the lifespan of the water pump, make sure the tank has enough water before powering it on to prevent it from pumping in air which causes slow water output and bubbles.

 **Attention**

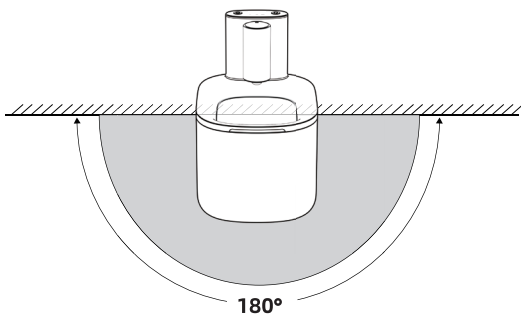
The battery is non-removable.
Do not attempt to disassemble it.



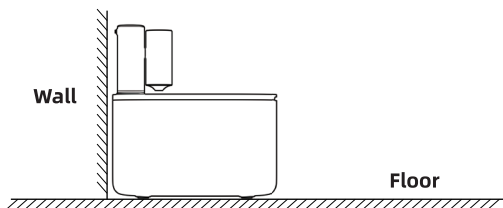
1. When low battery or low power is prompt, please charge the device as soon as possible to avoid affecting the battery life.
2. Avoid using the device below 5°C to avoid battery from degrading.
3. DO NOT expose the device to any direct heat source, including fire and direct sunlight.
4. Only use the accessories (adapter and cable) provided or following the device's specifications.
5. In the event the device will not be use for a long period of time, please charge the device until it is at full capacity before storing it away. Make sure to charge the device once every 6 months.
6. DO NOT dispose the device using fire, water or other liquids to avoid any explosive hazards.
7. DO NOT dispose the device as household waste. Please follow the local enviromental laws and regulations.
8. DO NOT heat (above 60°C) or incinerate the battery.

Smart Motion Sensor

1. The device has a built-in smart motion sensor and dispenses water when it detects movement within a 180° degree angle and 60cm radius.



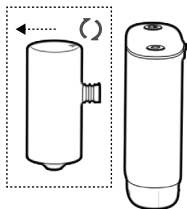
2. The back of the device is not able to detect movement. Hence, it's recommended to put the device against a wall.



3. To attract pets to drink water, the device will automatically dispense water once every 2 hours.

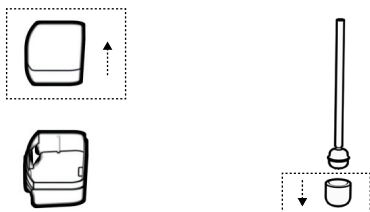
Filter Replacement

1. To avoid blockage inside the filter cartridge, **change the UF Filter Cartridge at least once a month**. When the filter change indicator is prompt, change the cartridge immediately.



2. To keep the water clean and maintain hygiene, it's recommended to **clean the foam filter at least once a week and replace it every two weeks**.

If the room temperature is high and you have more than one pet using the device, you should wash **more frequently**.



3. To avoid any potential risks caused by using filter from other sources, only use the filter set provided by Petea.

Cleaning and Maintenance

1. To maintain cleanliness and hygiene, it's recommended to clean the whole device thoroughly once a week.
2. Make sure to remove the control hub before washing. The Control Hub should never be wash or rinse.
3. DO NOT use a dishwasher. Please wash by hand.
4. Dish soap can be used to clean the device.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
The device does not dispense water or dispense slowly with a lot of bubbles.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Please make sure the tank has enough water.2. Then reboot the device to see if it works normally.3. Please reinstall the filter cartridge.
The water tank is dirty. The foam filter is dirty. The interior of the water tank / water tray is sticky.	<p>Clean the device and change the filter regularly.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Change the filter cartridge at least once a month.2. Change the foam filter at least once every two weeks.3. Clean the device thoroughly at least once a week.4. If the room temperature is high or if you have more than one pet using the device, please do cleaning and change filter more frequently. <p>Refer to Cleaning and Maintenance for more details.</p>
The device does not charge. Battery life is not as expected. The device would not turn on.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Do not place the device in area with high activity to reduce frequent motion detection and power consumption.2. Please use the provided power cable and adapter to charge the device.3. To avoid potential safety hazards, do not dismantle the device.

What is covered by this warranty?

What will Petea do in the event warranty is breached?
